DUNKLIN R-5 SAFETY AND SECURITY

Board of Education Meeting February 20, 2018

- District commissioned police officer-Covers all 4 school buildings and central office. Cost for officer and equipment is paid from district funds.
- Herculaneum Police Officer-Covers 3 school buildings in Herculaneum and central office. Cost is shared between City of Herculaneum and district. District share is \$17,500 per year.
- School Guard 911 app.-App allows staff to report an active shooter. App calls 911 and sends a push message to law enforcement.

- ALICE Training-Officer Grobe and Officer Kyle are certified ALICE trainers. Staff and students go through ALICE training and active shooter drills are conducted.
- All school buildings front doors have buzzer system and visitors have to be buzzed into building. Visitors sign in and receive a badge/pass to where they are going.
- High school has keypad access to theatre and industrial arts building.
- Pevely modular doors are locked.

- Camera system in place and is continuously being updated and cameras added. Video can be viewed in real time and can be reviewed. Administrators have iPads that can be used to view cameras.
- Emergency flip charts updated.
- Staff completed training provided by insurance company for bullying and suicide prevention.

- Pevely police officers direct traffic and visit Pevely Elementary.
- Comtrea liaison counselor meets with students.
- Every classroom has a phone and buildings have intercom systems.

IN PROGRESS

- Security fencing at Taylor, Pevely and STMS. Should be completed by late March or early April depending on weather.
- Taylor security fencing will connect main building and butterfly building. Buzzer door access will be moved to gate in the fence. Bollards also will be put in place to prevent car from driving into enclosed area.
- Pevely security fencing will enclose the modular buildings and main building.

IN PROGRESS

- STMS security fencing will enclose lower area between main building and gym.
- Implementation of new bullying prevention training.
- Pevely secretary moving to hallway by front doors.
- Comtrea dental clinic will include an office for counseling. Staffing still being discussed.
- Lock replacement on classroom doors.

FUTURE CONSIDERATIONS

- Revisit fencing for high school or keypad on gym building.
- Bollards in front of high school.
- Film on doors and windows that make them more resistant to breaking.
- Additional mental health options for students.
- Additional law enforcement in buildings either district commissioned or shared with cities. Goal would be at least 3 officers.

FUTURE CONSIDERATIONS

- Classroom door replacement at Taylor.
- Keypad or card access at all buildings.
- Architect could complete a safety and security audit of facilities.
