



Proposition S

Safety - Security - Storm Shelter

12 new classrooms at Pevely to accommodate 22% growth since 2008.

Prop S will eliminate the need for classroom trailers.

All students will be in the safety of the main building.

Expected \$ 1.4 million storm shelter grant if Prop S passes.

The cafeteria expansion will allow lunch to be served at a reasonable time.

Moving the bus garage will improve traffic flow, create a safer transition for students, add parking and keep the buses from being blocked in during an emergency.

Bonds issued by the school district = \$ 6 million

Tax levy increase = \$ 0.18

Additional cost for a \$ 100,000 home = \$ 2.85 per month

Election Day is August 7, 2018
